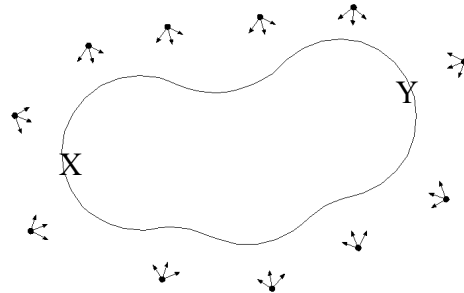

STEP 1 - Take four common measurements

Measurement Required	Description	Field Measurement
REFERENCE MEASUREMENT	Length between two marked locations (X & Y) preferably on opposite ends of pool	
WALL HEIGHT	Shortest distance from bead receptor track to bottom of steel wall	
DEEPEST DEPTH	Vertical distance from bead receptor track to bottom of pool deep end	
PERIMETER	Pool perimeter including inside stair face along coping track	

STEP 2 – Minimum 20-30 colour, 8 Mega-pixel (or higher) pictures of pool.

1. **Take Pictures:** Facing the wall opposite you, take two or three pictures from one spot so as to capture the entire pool, move, and repeat the process until you've walked the entire perimeter of the pool (see the photo samples).



Requirements

- Pictures must be clear and in focus
- Pictures must be taken in the same time frame for similar lighting (not some at 7am, and some at 5pm)
- The scene (pool) must be consistent with no moving people or objects in the pictures. Once you've begun taking pictures, do not move or remove anything from inside or around the pool.
- The pool must be empty and reasonably dry. Reflective surfaces like water can cause problems.
- Minimize deck in pictures.

How to get the best results

- Better picture quality produces better results, so ensure your camera is set for the highest quality
- Ensure your reference measurement is as accurate as possible, and is proportionate to the size of the pool.
- Include pictures of the entire pool (in a single shot) from different angles if possible
- Ensure your lens is clean
- Review your pictures upon completion to ensure they are clear and in focus
